Instead of euthanizing him, the shelter allowed Cooper to come into our program. After months of training and real life practice, we matched Cooper up with a disabled Veteran, needing

companionship and help with his mobility. These two are now like peas in a pod. Both needing something from each other, and sharing a feeling of being misjudged by others in their past, Cooper and his new dad bonded strongly right away. A beautiful thing.
